Meisterschüler\*innen of the summer semester 2025 and winter semester 2025/26 from the College of Fine Arts as well as Meisterschüler\*innen of the Art and Media program of the College of Design are eligible for the Udk Berlin Art Award. In addition, students from the Art and Media degree program who receive a written recommendation from a professor for the Meisterschüler\*innen degree are also eligible.

The artists who are nominated at the first jury meeting on March 10, 2026, agree to present their work during the nominee exhibition in the foyer/cross gallery at Hardenbergstraße 33 from May 21-23, 2026. They will participate in planning and installing the exhibition, which will be organized by Akiko Bernhöft, Curator for Examination and Exhibition Organisation at the College of Fine Arts.

For the purpose of promoting the nominated artists on the Udk Berlin website and via the Udk Berlin's social media channels, the nominated artists will provide the Department of Interfaculty Events (in cooperation with the Department of Press/Communication) with images of their own work and authorise the use of the artist statement for the Udk Berlin media.

The prize winners announced as of 21 May 2026 agree to make their works available for the prize winners' exhibition, which is scheduled to take place in November 2026 at the Kommunale Galerie Berlin, and to assist with the installation and transport of the exhibition. A fixed amount can be reimbursed for any transport and material costs incurred. In addition, the award winners will receive a fee for their work.

Monographic catalogues will be produced on the occasion of the exhibition. Each award winner will receive a catalogue of approximately 28 pages. All individual catalogues have the same size and a uniform graphic frame and are provided with a foreword by the President. The contents of the catalogue, such as texts and illustrations of works, are created independently by the award winners with the help of a style sheet provided by the Department for Interfaculty Events. The graphic design will be realised in collaboration with a graphic designer commissioned by the Department for Interfaculty Events. The prize winners will each receive 200 catalogues for free use.

The prerequisite for participation is the submission of complete application documents in the period from 1-28 February 2028.
